



How to: Upload files through a web browser

Status: You have video, audio or still images on a computer that you would like to upload into your FORscene account.

What next? Using FORscene's webupload page on your FORscene account, upload the files from any computer connected to the internet into your FORscene account.

How to do it?

1. To access FORscene's webupload page available from within your FORscene account, right click on the top level files button ⁽¹⁾ (this will open a new window so make sure you have pop-ups enabled).
2. Once this page has been loaded up, you will be asked for your account username and password
3. If you enter your username and password correctly, you will be presented with the webupload page (view image 1).
4. Click 'Browse...' to search your computer for the file.
5. Type in the name of the file you want it to be called within your FORscene account.
6. Next choose whether you want your video to be uploaded as PAL or NTSC, (PAL is used in Europe, Africa, and most parts of Asia and South America, while NTSC is used in Central and North America as well as parts of Asia including Japan).
7. Once you have completed the webupload form, click 'Upload file' (view image 2).
8. Once the file has been uploaded there will be a message at the top of the page to confirm: 'File (filename) uploaded to FORscene account (username)' (view image 3).
9. To view the file, close the webupload window down and go back to your FORscene account. The file will appear in the files window. Close and re-open the files window ⁽⁴⁾ to update the files list.
10. The FORscene webupload page can also be accessed from mobile phones so you can upload mobile videos or images directly into your FORscene account. This can be done by opening your mobile's web browser and go to your FORscene account URL adding '/webupload' at the end. E.g. <http://pro.forscene.net/demo/webupload>

Notes:

- The length of time for a file to upload depends on the size of the file and internet upload connection speed. (2mb ADSL broadband typically gives a 256kb upload speed).
